

## Guidelines for Print Show 2020 Submissions

- **Submissions accepted** from now – February 3.
- Types of **media** that can be submitted:
  - Drypoint,
  - Etching,
  - Ink,
  - Linoleum,
  - Relief
  - Screen
  - Digital produced on a computer using Photoshop or Illustrator (**not** a digital photo of other work)
  - Photography
- Fill out the **online submission form** completely, and upload a digital image of your submission (can be low resolution/from camera phone). **Accurate dimensions** (see below) are required.
- **Print the emailed receipt** from your online submission and attach it to the piece you are submitting.
- Submit the **actual piece** that will be framed for the show to a faculty member, with your name, title of the piece, and orientation attached. Only pieces that are suitable for framing will be considered. Photos and digital prints should be on glossy or matte photo paper. For oversize prints, Copydotcom, FedEx, and Costco offer affordable printing services. Selection will be based on the actual piece.
- Leave a **border** of at least 1/2 inch on all sides of the piece, so that it can be secured to the mat. Otherwise, your entire piece will not be visible inside the mat.
- **Accurate dimensions** mean measuring the dimensions of the piece that will show inside the mat, height x width in inches. Do not include the border that will attach to the mat in the measurements. The mats will be cut according to the dimensions YOU provide, so if you do not measure accurately, your piece may either be cut off, or show an unwanted border.
- You may submit up to **3 pieces**. Consider your audience when selecting pieces to submit—adults will purchase these works to hang in their homes. Colors, textures, and abstractions sell well, while cartoons, portraits, and violent or disturbing themes do not.
- **Work does not have to be done in this school year**, but more recent work is preferred. Please do not submit work done before you entered Kinder HSPVA.
- **Artists** of selected prints **will be notified** on February 15, and will have until March 1 to submit a **high resolution digital file** of the selected piece. Instructions for submitting the high resolution file will be provided in the notification letter. If necessary, the Visual Arts Department will provide assistance in documenting your work.
